## PERFORMANCE

Zeta's NTA per share increased in March, rising 3.8% from A\$0.485 to A\$0.504. The increase during the month was primarily due to increases in the share prices of Resolute Mining and Panoramic Resources.

## COMMODITY & CURRENCY MARKETS

Oil prices rose in March, with the price of Brent crude oil rising 7.4% from US\$64.59 at the end of February to US\$69.34 at the end of March. Nickel fell, with the price of nickel down 4.6% from US\$6.29 at the end of February to US\$6.01 at the end of March.

During the month, the US dollar gold price (London PM fix) increased 0.5% from \$1,318 at the end of February to \$1,324 at the end of March. The Australian dollar decreased in value against the US dollar, falling 1.4% from 0.7794 at the end of February to 0.7686 at the end of March.

## PORTFOLIO

The share price of Panoramic Resources rose 1.5 cents during February, closing the month at A\$0.455. Resolute Mining's share price was up 13.55 cents to A\$1.245. Copper Mountain Mining's share price was down 1 cent to C\$1.19. Bligh Resources' share price was unchanged during March, closing the month at A\$0.036.

During March, the scheme of arrangement by which Copper Mountain Mining acquired Altona Mining was approved by shareholders, with the combined investment becoming Zeta's third largest holding.

## DEBT

At month-end Zeta had A\$40.0m in net debt (Feb: A\$35.5m).

## OTHER

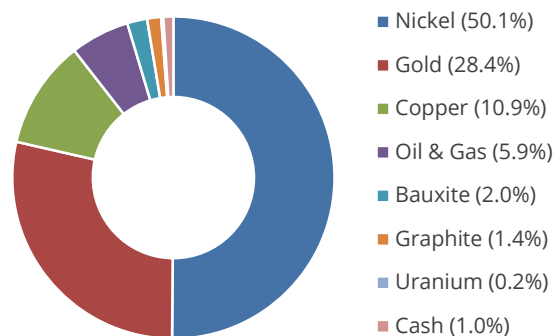
Zeta's share price closed March at A\$0.38, a discount to NTA of 24.5%. At the end of February, the shares closed at a discount to NTA of 21.7%.

In November 2017, Zeta announced that it had agreed to acquire Axelrock Limited. Should the acquisition be completed, this will substantially increase Zeta's holdings in Seacrest and GME, and bauxite company AMC.

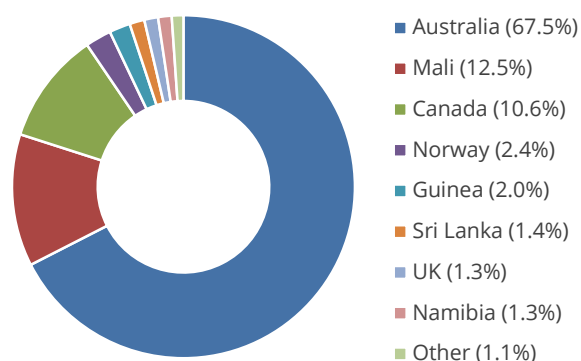
